Division & Class Specifications

Leadline(1,2,3): Open to riders 7 years and under. Rider not eligible for any other classes. Rider to be led at the walk. Pony to be on lead at all times.

BHSA Leadline Class(3): Open to children 7 years and younger as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders not allowed to cross enter into any classes where they would be asked to trot. Points go to the rider.

BHSA Pre Short Stirrup (4, 5, 6): Open to riders 10 years & under as of Dec 1 of the current show year. Riders may be asked to walk, trot, and perform simple Equitation tasks. Riders not allowed to cross enter into classes where they would be asked to canter or jump.

VHSA Short Stirrup Hunter (7, 8, 9): 18" straight rails - Open to riders 12 years & under. Trotting is permitted. RIDERS and MOUNTS may cross enter only into pleasure and non-VHSA classes.

VHSA /BHSA HUNTER PLEASURE PONY (10, 11, 12): Junior riders on ponies only. May be combined with Junior Hunter Pleasure Horse and/or Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse, if less than 3 entries. Judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going.

VHSA /BHSA PONY EQUITATION (13): Open to juniors on ponies. Jump heights to be a minimum of 2' for Small Ponies, 2'3" for Medium Ponies and 2'6" for Large Ponies. To be shown over a course of at least 6 fences. Rider can only accumulate points from one class per show.

VHSA /BHSA PONY HUNTER (14, 15, 16):

Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Jump heights to be a minimum of 2' for Small Ponies, 2'3" for Medium Ponies and 2'6" for Large Ponies. Ad

BHSA-VHSA Green Pony/Green Hunter Horse(17, 18, 19, 29, 30, 31): Green Ponies: Junior riders only. Open to ponies in their first year of showing over fences as of Dec 1 of the current show year. Jump heights to be a minimum of 2' for Small Ponies, a minimum of 2'3" for Medium Ponies, a minimum of 2'6" for Large Ponies. **Green Hunter:** Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher as of Dec 1 of the current show year. Jump heights to be a minimum of 2'6".

VHSA /BHSA HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE (20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25):

Junior Riders(20,21,22) on horses only. May be combined with Hunter Pleasure Pony and/or Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse, if less than 3 entries. Judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going. Horses may not cross enter into another Pleasure Division at the same show. **Adult Riders(23,24,25)** on horses only. May be combined with Hunter Pleasure Pony and/or Junior Hunter Pleasure Horse, if less than 3 entries. Judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going. Horses may not cross enter into another Pleasure Division at the same show.

BHSA LOW HUNTER (26, 27, 28): Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Jump heights to be a minimum of 2' and not to exceed 2'3". May be combined with the Schooling Hunter if either or both do not have 3 entries. If combined, entries must jump the correct height for their division.

BHSA SCHOOLING HUNTER (32, 33, 34): Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a Pony division. Jump heights to be a minimum of 2'6" and not to exceed 3'. May be combined with the Low Hunter if either or both do not have 3 entries. If combined, entries must jump the correct height for their division.

VHSA/BHSA Children/Junior/Adult Amateur Equitation (35):

Children's Equitation: Open to juniors & adult amateurs mounted on horses. Jump heights to be a minimum of 2'6" and not to exceed 3'. To be shown over a course of at least 6 fences.

VHSA/BHSA CHILDREN/ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER (36, 37, 38):

Children's Hunter: Open to horses ridden by juniors. Jump heights to be a minimum of 2'6". **Adult Amateur Hunter:** Open to horses, and ponies not ridden in a Pony division. Ridden by Adult Amateurs. Jump heights to be a minimum of 2'6".

VHSA/BHSA THOROUGHBRED HUNTER (39, 40, 41):

Open to registered TBs and horses eligible to be registered. Fences 2'6". No restriction on riders. Thoroughbred Hunter may only be combined with the Working Hunter and the Green Hunter. Each horse in this combined division must still be qualified for their respective division and jump the regulation height (minimum of 2'6").

VHSA/ BHSA WORKING HUNTER (42, 43, 44):

2'9" or 3' (Junior and Adult). Open to all horses and ponies not entered in a Pony division.
