

# Summer Series Award Rules & Points System

1. All riders must declare their age in the appropriate box on the entry form. This is the rider's/ exhibitor's sole responsibility. Undeclared riders will not be eligible for end of series awards.
2. Juniors, amateurs and professionals are defined by USEF/USHJA rules.
3. Awards to be offered at the shows are included in this prize list. Horse-rider combinations must show in at least two of the series' shows to be eligible for series-end high point awards
4. Inclement weather: Shows may be cancelled at management's discretion on the basis of severe weather conditions. When weather is inappropriate for outdoor ring use but not severe enough for show cancellation only Hunter Flat/Over Fence Classes will run in the Indoor Arena.
5. The point structure for all Divisions/Classes will consist of Base Points, plus Bonus Points, to equal Final Points as listed below:

## **Hunter and Hunter Pleasure Divisions**

Base Points are 1st through 6th as follows: 10 - 6 - 4 - 2 - 1 - .5

Bonus Points will be determined by the number of horses or ponies shown successfully (completed the course) in the first performance class of all Hunter Divisions and the number of horses or ponies shown in the first class of the Hunter Pleasure Divisions. This number of exhibitors in the first class sets the bonus points for the remainder of the classes in the division. We still require three (3) entries to fill a class, but will award a Champion and Reserve if there are a minimum of three (3) entries in any two (2) of the three (3) classes offered. Bonus Points can be no more than ten (10). Champion shall receive an additional ten (10) points and Reserve six (6) points.

## **Equitation Over Fences, Equitation on the Flat and Jumper Classes**

Bonus Points will be decided by the number of participants in each particular class and scored as in the preceding example. "For Jumpers in individual classes, exhibitors who are tied for 1st place after the initial rounds must jump off, refer to USEF Rule JP141. All other ties will be decided by a judges coin toss

## Summer Series Overall High Point Awards

### **Junior Grand High Point & Reserve High Point:**

*Awarded to the top two eligible junior horse/rider combinations*

### **Adult Amateur Grand High Point & Reserve High Point:**

*Awarded to the top two eligible adult amateur horse/rider combinations*

### **Professional Grand High Point & Reserve High Point:**

*Awarded to the top two eligible professional horse/rider combinations*

### **Grand High Point Trainer(\$300) & Reserve High Point Trainer(\$200):**

*Awarded to the top two eligible trainers based on the cumulative points of their registered horse/rider combinations. Trainers please make sure your riders put your name on all entry forms.*
