

Summer Series Show Rules

1. ASTM/SEI Certified Helmets with harness fastened must be worn when mounted.
2. Class fees are \$20 for jumper classes and \$15 for hunter/ equitation classes day of show. Pre-registered riders will receive \$3 off per class that is pre-registered at www.fryingpanequestrian.org. Pre-registrations must be received by 11am the day of the show to be eligible and cannot be changed the day of the show. Class additions day of show to a pre-registered horse/ rider combination will not receive the pre-registration discount.
3. New back/bridle numbers will be issued at each show unless otherwise requested by the rider on their entry form.
4. Entry fees will not be refunded for a class once that class has begun. If you need to scratch a class, you must do so prior to the beginning of the class/ division. Any class shown in and not entered before the class starts will be charged the entry fee plus a \$5.00 office charge.
5. The protocol for showing in hunter, jumper and/or equitation classes varies between class and division. Riders who are not familiar with the protocol are encouraged to speak with the show secretary before the start of the show.
6. A current negative Coggins (taken within 12 months) must be provided at each show before a back number will be issued for all entrants. Entrants shipping from out of state should also provide a current clear certificate of health for each horse brought over state lines in accordance with federal agriculture law.
7. The show will be run with U.S.E.F. rules as guidelines but is not an associate member show. Horse/ Rider combinations are only eligible for FPDF Summer Series points.
8. Frying Pan Farm Park, Fairfax County Park Authority, Founders, Benefactors, Supervisors and Friends of Frying Pan Farm Park, their employees and volunteers will not be responsible for any accident, injury or loss occurring during the shows. Exhibitors enter the show under this condition.
9. There will be six ribbons in all classes. Champion and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions and as specified in the Award Rules.
10. Horses and ponies may cross enter where eligible .
11. No horse/rider combination may enter in more than 9 classes and 3 warm-ups per show day and no single horse may be entered in more than 12 over fences classes and 4 warm-ups / limit of 2 riders per horse per show day with the exception of classes 1-7 .
12. Entries showing un-judged will be limited to the end of the class. Un-judged entries pay the same entry fee for each round.
13. There will be an order of go established with the end gate manager for each class/division. Riders must be ready to go in the posted order, and within one minute of being called, or risk elimination.
14. A \$50 fee will be charged on returned checks.
15. All unmounted horses brought onsite must stabled or left on trailers. It is prohibited to leave a horse/ dog tied and unattended while on the premises. All dogs must be leashed or in a controlled environment at all times.
16. Frying Pan Farm Park's Fundraiser Horse Show proceeds benefit the Friends of Frying Pan Farm Park, a 501(c)3 charitable organization
17. \$15 Grounds Fee (Required for all Riders who do not have a current Annual or Quarterly Riding Pass) *Subject to Verification: If you have a current riding pass uncheck this box
18. Inhumane treatment of any animal and unsportsmanlike like conduct from any competitor will not be tolerated. Management reserves the right to dismiss any competitor immediately for the aforementioned.
